- Be the main point of contact for parents during the months of June – August
- Responsible for coordinating and organizing class rosters
- Assist with parent orientations and maintain communication with parents
- Handle all participants, volunteers, potential donors and parents in a polite and courteous manner
- Ensure that classes are set up according to the lesson plan at least 15 minutes prior to the start of the scheduled lesson. This always includes staying after class to clean up
- Aid the Director of Programming in creating lesson plans; ability to modify lesson plans
- Be available to conduct in-school and after-school programming October - March
