



## BEST PRACTICE AND LESSON PLAN IDEAS

Category: Safety and Class Management

Suggested Grade: 5<sup>th</sup>

Title: Caddy and Player

Equipment/Materials:

- Bull's Eye Targets (4)
- Wedge clubs (4)
- Tees and mat (4)
- Golf balls (12)
- Poly spots (4)

Description:

- I use the poly spots to mark where to place the golf balls for their player. The caddy stands about 40 feet away from the player holding the bull's eye target at chest level. The player is going to try to launch the ball to the target. The caddy's job is to say "clear" when it is safe for the player to hit. The caddy holding the target can move to try to catch the ball if the player doesn't hit the ball right at the target. I explain each job to the students and then they rotate until they have been a caddy and player.
